Dear Mr. Lilly:

By this letter we are giving tentative approval for a well to be dually completed known as your #2 Jicarilla-Apache in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4-26N-5W as set out in your application of July 7, 1956.

We understand this well will be dually completed in the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations. We also understand that completion will be made with a 2" single tubing string, with two Garrett Oil Tools, Inc. Type B Circulating Valve and a Model HD-100 Sweet Hookwall Separation Packer. Upon completion you should file formal application with Mr. A. L. Porter, Secretary-Director of the Oil Conservation Commission, Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico, describing in detail how the well is equipped and completed. Offset operators should also be sent a copy of this application by registered mail. Final approval will be given by Mr. Porter after waiting 20 days for objections from offset operators.

This well is located in Unit B, Section 4, T-26-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.


