Sept. 24, 1966. Ran 237 joints of 4 1/2" OD 11.6# 8rd J55 LT&C-SP&C casing. Overall length 7528.08, effective length 7475.04. Cemented casing by Halliburton. 1st stage 190 sacks regular cement, 12% gel, 12% salt, 1/2% CFR 2, followed with 300 sacks regular cement with 12% salt and 7% sand with 3/4% CFR 2, plug down at 8:15PM. Opened DV tool and circulated, waited four hours and cemented 2nd stage at 5168 with 450 sacks regular cement with 12% gel, 12% salt, plug down at 1:15 AM 25th. Opened DV tool at 3244.98 and cemented third stage with 400 sacks regular cement with 12% gel, 12% salt and 1/2% CFR 2 and 300 sacks regular cement and 7% salt per sack, 3/4% CFR 2. Plug down at 6:45AM, 9-25-66. No cement returns. W.O.C.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
