Reference is made to the following well No. 4 Jicarilla C, SE/4NW/4 sec. 24, T. 26 N., R. 5 W., Lease Jicarilla Contract 108, New Mexico and your Sundry Notice approved on August 24, 1990, requesting approval to restore Dakota production. If the work on the subject well has been completed you are required to submit a Subsequent Report.
