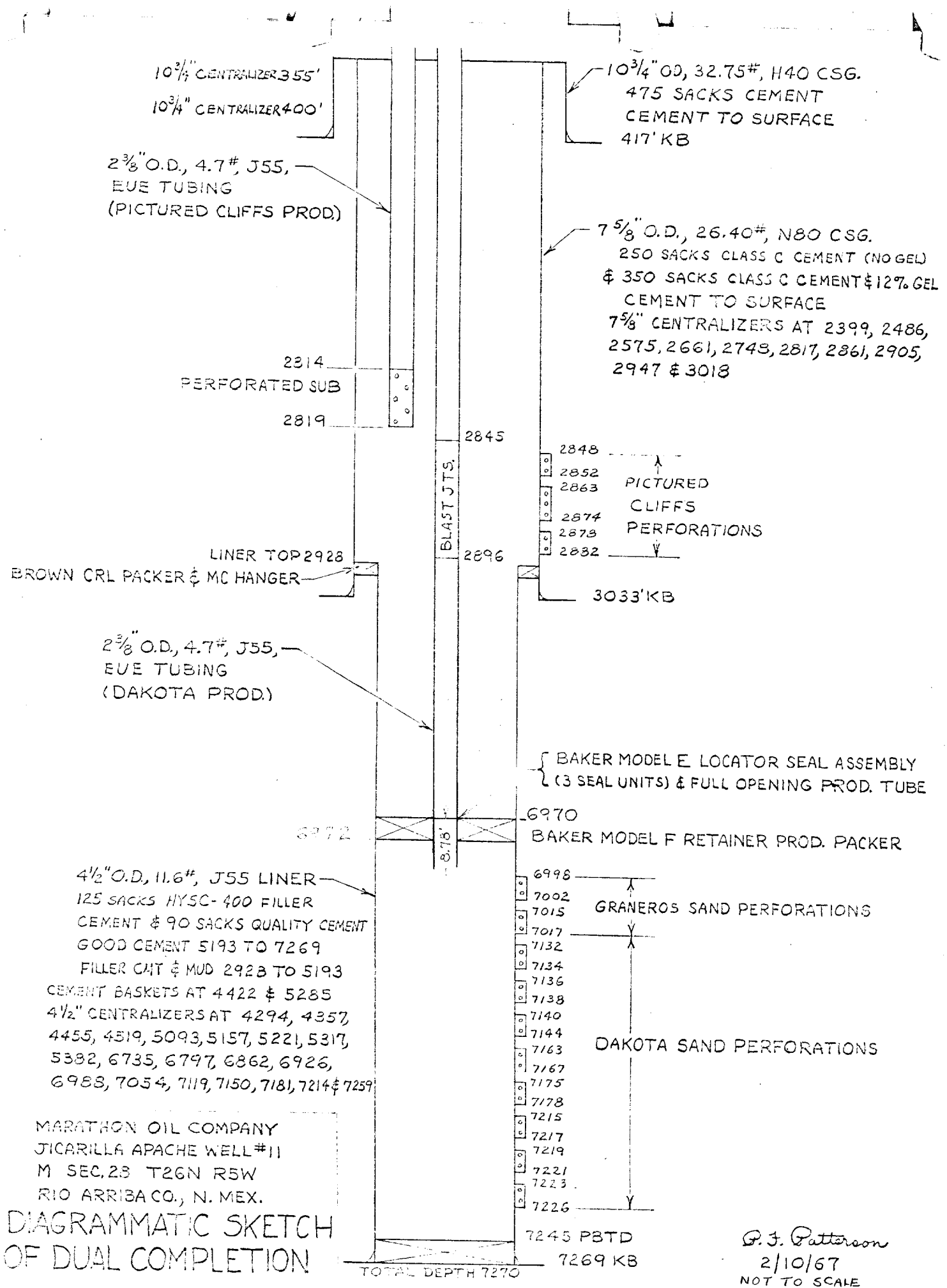

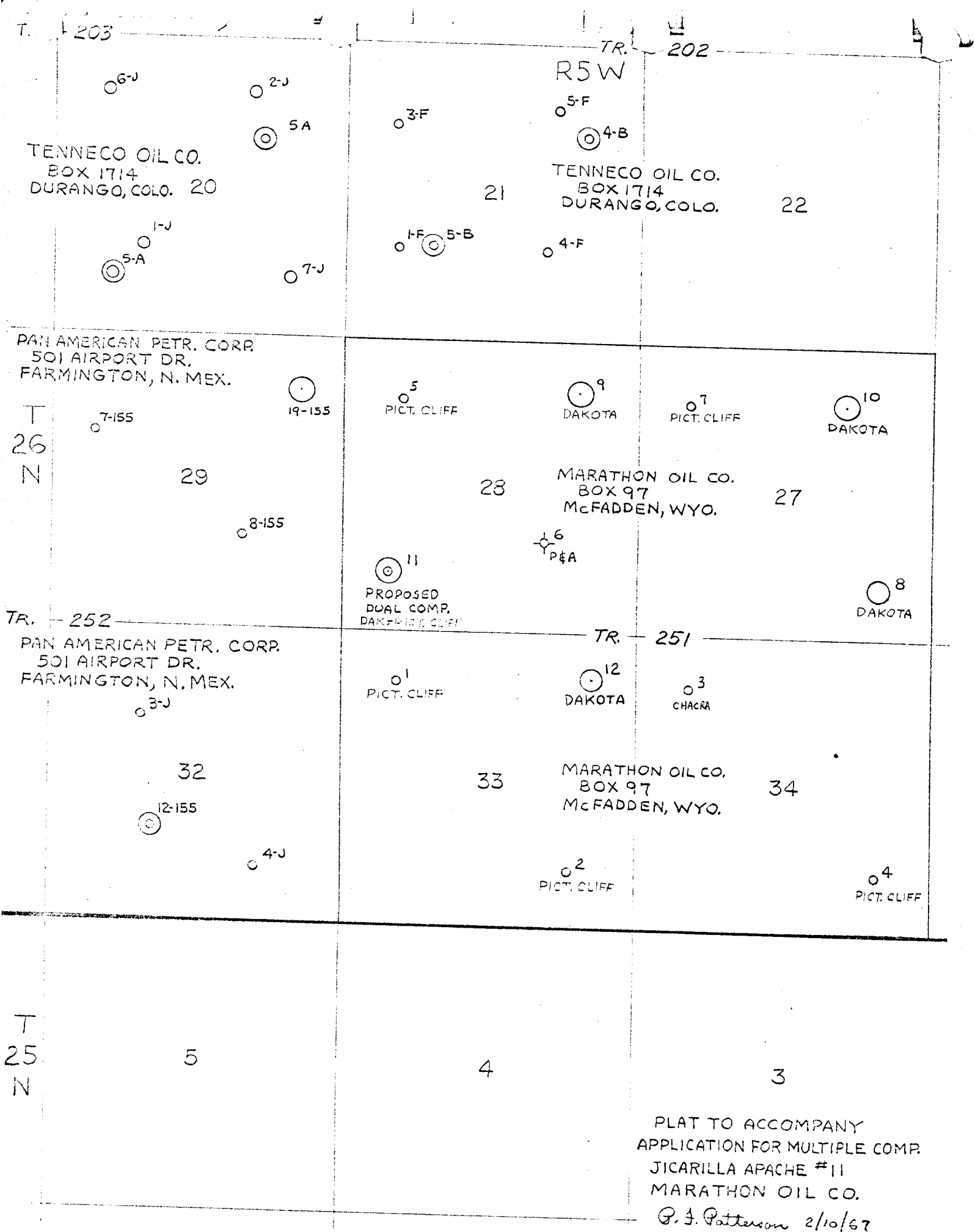


DIAGRAMMATIC SKETCH OF DUAL COMPLETION
