Dear Mr. Porter:

As provided for in order #N-2565, Entry 4, covering the Puerto Chiquito Mancos Field, Dr. Samuel G. Dunn requests administrative approval to drill the Puerto Chiquito No. 20 well on an unorthodox location. The Puerto Chiquito No. 20 well will be a Mancos completion located 1990 feet from the south line and 950 feet from the east line of Section 27, T-26N, R-1E, N10 Arriba County, New Mexico.

The unorthodox location is requested in order to move the location out of an arroyo. Dr. Samuel G. Dunn operates the lease covering the W/2 of Section 26. Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corporation, an operator of the Puerto Chiquito Unit, is the only offset operator and has been notified of the application by registered mail. Mr. Greer has been asked to provide a written waiver in order to expedite the application and permit drilling operations to commence as soon as possible.
