

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 28, 1967, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "101" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

NOW, on this 17th day of September, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "101" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Article 17-A, Ley de Comercio para el Petróleo, the Commission has issued the following order to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 27, 1957, for petition to qualify complete its jurisdiction over well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such manner as to produce gas from the Tapachto-Placitas Oil Pool and the Blanco-Hesperus Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of September, 1957, the Secretary of the Commission orders:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Article 17-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That said necessary information has been provided and all necessary of record records have been duly notified and returned;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed final completion will not cause waste nor impact conservative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed final completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Artes Oil & Gas Company, Inc., be and is hereby authorized to qualify complete the jurisdiction over well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such manner as to produce gas from the Tapachto-Placitas Oil Pool and the Blanco-Hesperus Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall complete, install and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Article 17-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall have governing interest upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Responsibility Test Period for the Blanco-Hesperus Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the event of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary. DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinafore designated.
