

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 28, 1967, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "101" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

NOW, on this 17th day of September, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "101" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A, Arts 61 & 62, the Commission on the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, on August 17, 1937, for petition to finally complete its jurisdiction, "Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 1, Township 36 North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapachto-Placitas Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Havender Pool."

Now, on this 17th day of September, 1937, the Secretary, Director of the

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That said necessary information has been provided and all necessary of record, records have been duly notified and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed final completion will not cause waste nor impair conservative rights;
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed final completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation standards.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Artes Oil & Gas Company, Inc., and its agent, is hereby authorized to finally complete the Unit A of Section 1, Township 36 North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapachto-Placitas Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Havender Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, install and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall have proper-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Reliability Test Period for the Blanco-Havender Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary. DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinafore designated.
