We have received completion papers and form C-104, Request for an Allowable, for a well located in the northeast quarter of Section 35, Township 26 North, Range 6 West which is designated as the Joseph B. Gould, Skelly #2. Our previous records on this well show Perry & Faast Drilling Co. as operator and I presume that you have purchased the well from them. I am returning form C-104 so that you may complete the form by indicating change in ownership in the proper blank. Will you please then return the forms to us?

We have also determined that another well previously designated as the Perry & Faast Drilling Co., Skelly #1 and located in the northwest matter of section 35 was approved for transfer to Joseph B. Gould to form C-104 submitted August 18, 1967. We have also discovered we do not have a plugging bond with Joseph B. Gould as principal and therefore should not have approved the transfer.
