Our Jicarilla "J" No. 10 well (Dakota-Gallup), located in Section 26, Township 26 North, Range 5 West was commingled in September, 1983.

We did not have an increase in production after the well was commingled. Therefore, we recommend that for the present time all of the production be allocated to the Dakota zone and none to the Gallup zone.
