A 12 1/4" hole will be drilled to approximately 200' and 8 5/8" surface pipe run and cemented to surface. A 7 7/8" hole will then be drilled to sufficient depth to test the Dakota formation, approximately 7850'. If commercial production is indicated 4 1/2" casing will be run and cemented in three stages. The first stage will be cemented with 200 sx.; the second through stage collar below the Navasota w/660 cu. ft. and the third stage through stage tool below the Pictured Cliffs formation w/900 cu. ft. The Dakota will then be SWF, tbg. run and the well completed.

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, as indicated, on all types of lands and leases for appropriate action by either a Federal or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 1: If the proposal is to redrill to the same reservoir at a different subsurface location or to a new reservoir, use this form with appropriate notations. Consult applicable State or Federal regulations concerning subsequent work proposals or reports on the well.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
