- 1-21-69 thru 3-31-69 Waiting on improved weather conditions
- 4-1-69 Fraced well thru perforations at 3970'-82', 3996'-4004' and 4012'-20' with 1000 gal gelled water, followed with 35,000 gal gelled water containing 35,000# 20/40 sand, flushed with 1500 gal gelled water. BOP 4000#, average injection rate 41 BPM at 2700#. SIP 100#. 15 minute SIP-0#.
- 4-8-69 Checked and found no fillup ran 1 1/2" tbg to 4022'.
- 4-14-69 Swabbed well, in cleaning up to pit.
- 4-15/26-69 Well cleaned up and ready for production.
