

THE APPLICATION OF AMOCO PRODUCTION  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2105

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Amoco Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 5, 1974, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Contract 155 Well No. 22, located in Unit I of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Gonzales Mesa-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of April, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Amoco Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Contract 155 Well No. 22, located in Unit I of Section 31, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Gonzales Mesa-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
