That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "G" Well Wo. 5 located in Unit L of Section 12, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Messwerde Pool and the Basin-Daketa Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTYR. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
