

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO  
NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A  
DUAL COMPLETION (TUBINGLESS)

ORDER NO. MC-1904

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 29, 1969, for permission to dually complete its Klein Well No. 11 located in Unit I of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool.

Now, on this 2nd day of January, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That the only offsetting operator being El Paso Natural Gas Company, the waiting period as prescribed by said rule, may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Klein Well No. 11 located in Unit I of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 29, 1939, for permission to drill complete its Klein Well No. 11 located in Unit I of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, T10M, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the south Blanco-Piñon Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chaco Pool.

Now, on this 2nd day of January, 1940, the Secretary  
Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified, and
- (3) That the only offsetting operation being El Paso Natural Gas Company, the waiting period as prescribed by said rule, shall be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the completion of the proposed dual completion is feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete its Klein Well No. 11 located in Unit I of Section 30, Township 30 North, Range 6 West, T10M, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the south Blanco-Piñon Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chaco Pool through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
