13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work. This well, which was recently acquired by Conoco from Nassau, was originally completed in the Dakota but has not produced since the 1970's. The original owner Jerome P. McHugh secured a downhole commingling order (No. R-5409) from the OCD in 1977 to commingle the Dakota and Mesaverde in this well. However, no official production was apparently reported from the Mesaverde and the well has remained shut-in since the testing of the Mesaverde.

Conoco proposes to production test the Mesaverde completion by setting a 4-1/2" bridge plug at 6100' to isolate the Dakota completion. Depending on the results of this test Conoco will evaluate whether it is economically feasible to return this well to commingled production from the Dakota and Mesaverde or if it should be permanently abandoned. It is anticipated that this evaluation will be completed by the 1st of September of this year.
