Gentlemen:

The drilling of your No. 17 Jicarilla "A" well, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 14, T. 26 N., R. 4 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Jicarilla lease Contract 135, was approved on May 2, 1974.

By telephone conversation of today, you advised that this well will be drilled to a different depth in another location and that the existing well pad will be restored to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

Our copy of application to drill in the original location is returned herewith and approval to drill is hereby rescinded. It is our understanding that the revised location for this well will be in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the same section and will be drilled to the Todito formation instead of the Pictured Cliffs formation.

Please file six copies of "Application to Drill," location plats and surface plan attachments for the new location for approval by this office.
