Following is our 12 point development plan for surface use on our well No. 258, located in section 18 26N 6W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

- (1) Existing State Road 403 will be used.
- (2) (5) (8) (9) No new roads, tanks, airstrip or camp.
- (3) (4) See Topo map.
- (6) Water will be hauled from Caulkins water hole in Section 13 26N 7W.
- (7) All cuttings, trash, garbage and etc. will be confined to reserve pit.
- (10) Layout plat for location and pit attached.
- (11) Reserve pit will be leveled and cleaned up, then complete area reseeded.
- (12) Location will be built over existing road. Main road in canyon will be routed over edge of location. Vegetation is dense sage brush.
