2. Run I.M.S. and Density logs.
3. Run 3862 ft. of 7-5/8", 26.40#, J-55 casing.
4. Cement 4/207 cu. ft. of class "C" cement.
5. Drill 6-3/4" hole to T.D. of 5925 ft. Run I.M.S. and Density logs.
6. Run 53 jts. (2232') of 4 1/2", 10.5#, K-55 Csg on T.I.W. liner hanger. Csg. landed at 5925'. Top of T.I.W. liner hanger at 3693 ft.
7. Cemented with 550 cu. ft. of 50-90 pebbles.
8. Perforate Mesaverde zone with 1 shot at 5428, 5434, 5438, 5471, 5475, 5478, 5513, 5540, 5547, 5621, 5685, 5698, 5709, 5720, 5726, 5729, 5734, 5790 and 5804 ft.
9. Run 500 gallons of 7 1/2% HCL Acid and ball off.
10. Free with 80,000 gallons of water and 80,000# 20-40 sand.
11. Set Baker Model "P" production packer with expendable plug at 5394 ft.
12. Perforate Pictured Cliffs zone w/1 shot/ft. from 3560 ft. to 3570 ft.
13. Spearhead with 500 gallons of HCL Acid.
14. Free with 40,000 gallons of water and 40,000# of 20-40 sand.
15. Run 5394' of 2-1/16" I.J. 3.25# Tbg and landed in Baker Model "P" packer w/ pump out plug.
16. Run 3548 ft. of 1-1/2", 2.9#, K.U.E. Tubing. Landed at 3548 ft.
17. Nipple up wellhead.
18. Pump plug out of 2-1/16" I.J. Tubing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
