

Dakota (Total Dakota Production) 927 Bbl Oil

 (Total Combined Production) 5,725 Bbl Oil = 16%

Mesa Verde (Total Mesa Verde Production) 4,798 Bbl Oil

 (Total Combined Production) 5,725 Bbl Oil = 84%
