DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill 9-7/8" hole to approx 140', set 7-1/8" casing and cement to surface w/75 cu yd. Drill 6-1/4" hole to total depth of 200', set 4" casing and cement w/100 cu yd. Furthermore the 4" casing from 107'-200' and fracture the fractured cliffs w/approx 40,000 gals water and 20,000 cu. ft. steam out, keep 1 1/2" casing at 200' and mud well in. The NW 1/4 of Section 30, containing 161.12 acres, is dedicated to the well.
