Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter of August 10, we have recently filed Self-Certification as to Successor Operator for the #1 Wildfire located on the captioned lease.

As to plans for the #1 Wildfire, our review of the available information indicates to us that the Mesa Verde formation warrants testing before the well is plugged. It is our intention to pursue this as soon as we can obtain approval from our joint interest owner. We have had some delay in obtaining this approval since the remaining interest in the well has been sold twice since we took it over. We have been advised by the last owner that the sale process is continuing, but they will not give us the name of the new prospective purchaser.

We presume that these matters will be resolved in the next few weeks; and that in due course we will be filing with you a proposal to rework the well and test the Mesa Verde formation.
