Dear Sir:

Our State "A" D-268 well, Unit P of Section 16-26N-6W, Rio Arriba County, was re-completed in the Dakota zone in January, 1961. A deliverability test was made 1-23-61 to 1-31-61 which resulted in a test volume of 408 MCF.

The well was operated almost continuously during February and March and during that time the production increased from approximately 450 MCF to 850 MCF per day.

A second deliverability test was made 4-23-61 to 4-30-61 which resulted in a test volume of 715 MCF. This test was filed May 15, 1961. Since this test is obviously more indicative of the well's true deliverability, we request that you please consider this test as the final test after work-over and issue appropriate allowable supplements. We would also like to have this test considered the annual test for the year 1961.
