

THE APPLICATION OF TENNECO OIL
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1723

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Tenneco Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 24, 1960, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "B" Well No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 21, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPN, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from an Undesignated Gallup Pool and the Basin-Dakota pool.

Now, on this 11th day of August, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair relative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "B" Well No. 4 located in Unit H of Section 21, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPN, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from an Undesignated Gallup Pool and the Basin-Dakota pool through installed strings of tubing.

FOURTHER ORDERED. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall have a her-leakage tests upon completion shall comply, hereafter, with the standard well-completing Test Series for the Basin-Dakota pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
