

THE APPLICATION OF COMPASS EXPLORATION,
INC., FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1313

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Compass Exploration, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on April 12, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Northwest Lindrith Well No. 2-4 located in Unit F of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Largo-Gallup Gas Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 3rd day of May, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

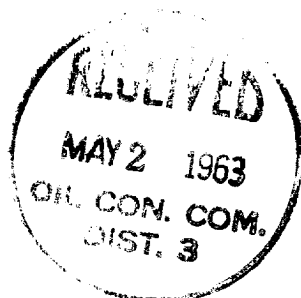
That the applicant herein, Compass Exploration, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Northwest Lindrith Well No. 2-4 located in Unit F of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Largo-Gallup Gas Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take certain leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That production of this order is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
