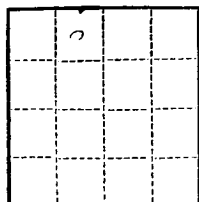

DETAILS OF WORK

Will set 10-3/4", 32.75#, "R"-40, seamless, spang, new casing to 200' with 150 sacks.
Will drill 8-3/4" hole thru Gallup (Tocito) to estimated TD of 4900'.
Will core 100' of Gallup section with full barrel core; if sufficient showings of oil or gas will run one DST.
If production obtained will run 8-1/2", "J"-55, 140, seamless, new casing and cement as needed for depth run.
If dry will plug and abandon in accordance with current practices for area.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
