

Would you please advise as to that status of the allowable and as to whether or not you have received the required report.

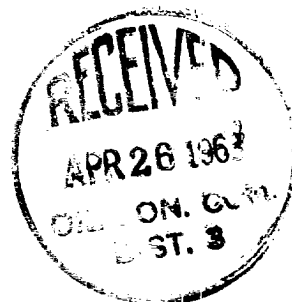
