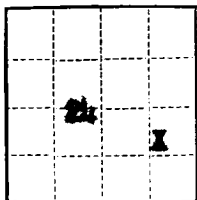

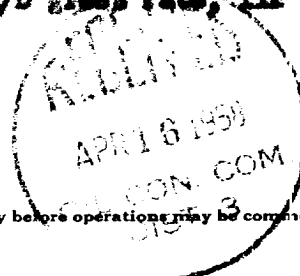

DETAILS OF WORK

- 1-30-58 Cemented 4 1/2", 9.5#, J-55 casing at 4989' with 150 sack regular cement.
- 2-16-58 Perforated four 1/2" holes/ft. 4858-72, 4887-4902, 4904-13, 4915-33, 4941-53, 4957-71'.
- 2-23-58 Sand-oil fractured with 47,000 gal. crude oil and 1#/gal. 20-40 mesh sand.
- 3-3-58 Swabbed total of 475 bbls. free oil, well would not flow.
- 3-18-58 Installed WPA Pump at 4800'.
- 4-7-58 Initial Production: Pumping (7 1/2 hr. test) 112 B/D gross rate, 112 B/D oil rate, cut 0.1%, 36.4 MCF/D gas rate, GOR 340.
