DETAILS OF WORK

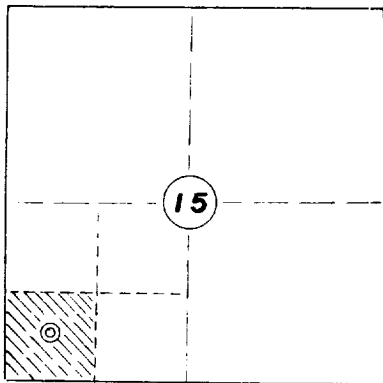
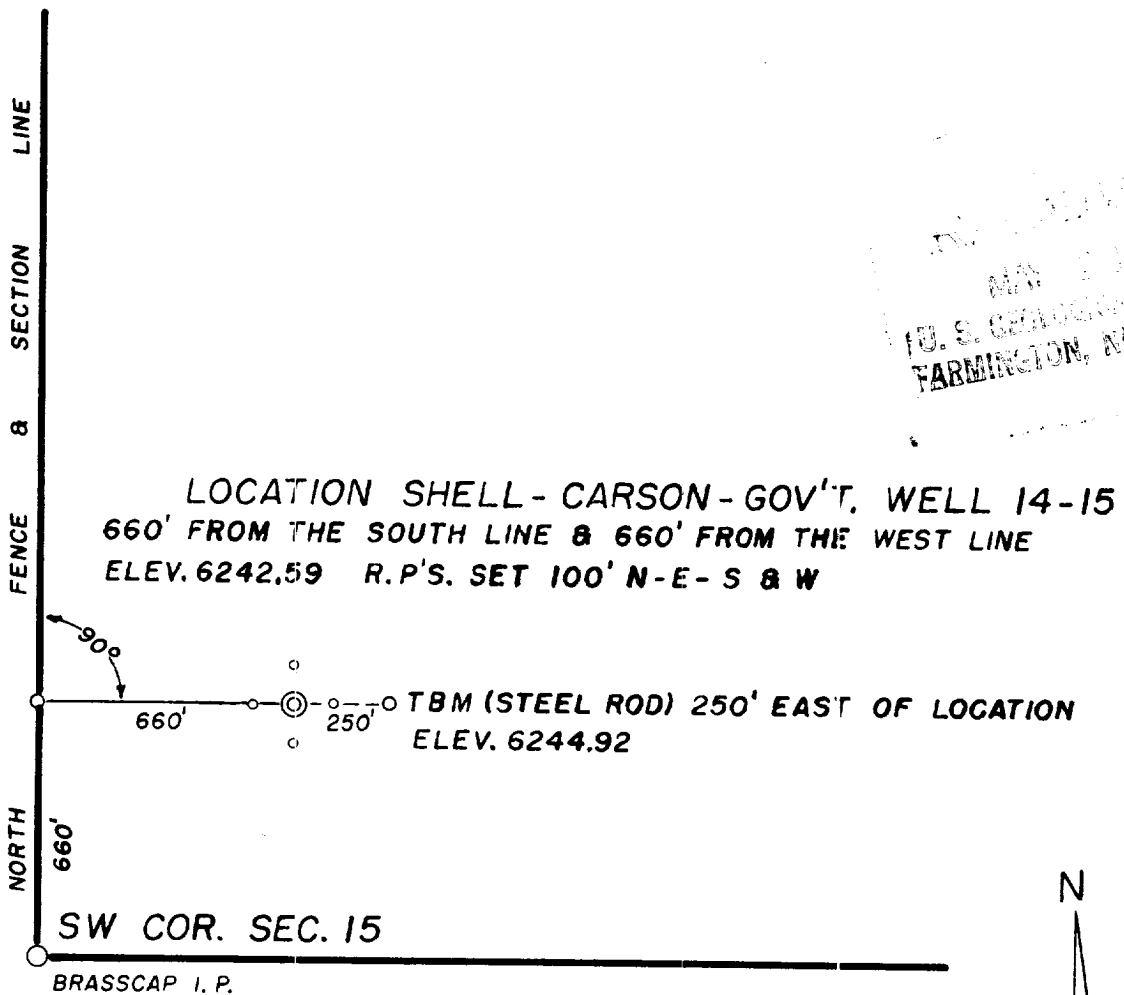

1. Drill 11" hole to 200'±.
2. Run and cement 8 5/8" casing at 200'± with sufficient cement to reach surface.
3. Drill 7 7/8" hole to a total depth of 4850'±.
4. If commercial production is obtained a supplementary completion notice will be filed, otherwise, plug and abandon in accordance with U.S.G.S. regulations.

Surface formation is Ojo Alamo.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
