Dear Mr. Stanley:

Reference is made to your inquiry regarding the James V. Reynolds #1 Weaver well located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15-25N-11W, San Juan County, New Mexico:

This well was completed February 9, 1959 through perforations at 4812-36' in the Gallup Formation. The potential was reported as 20 BOPD. The well was assigned an allowable on September 6, 1959 for 20 barrels of oil per day. Subsequent to this the well was shut in by the Commission for failure to file a gas-oil ratio test and it is our understanding that the operator was having difficulty in producing the well.

Recently the operator requested a testing allowable in order to try to clean the well up and secure a new test. This was granted April 2, 1960.

Our production reports do not reflect that production has been reported on the well for the last several months. I hope the above is the information which you desire.
