**Plugging and Abandonment Procedure
Carson Unit 11 Well No. 13
Attachment "A"**

WELL DATA:

Location: 1910' FSL, 590' FWL, Section 11, T25N, R12W
San Juan County, New Mexico

TD: 4920'
PBTD: 1148'

Surface Casing: 8-5/8", 24 ppf, J-55 set @ 107'. Cement w/ 100 sks cement.

Production Casing: 4-1/2", 9.5 14 ppf, J-55, set @ 4916'. Cement with 150 sks cement.

Perforations: 1112' - 1136' w/ 4 JSPF

PROCEDURE:

1. Pull and lay down 1 1/4" tubing.
2. Pick up 2 3/8" work string. TIH and set cement retainer @ 1000'.
3. Mix and pump 15 sacks (17.7 cuft) cement below retainer.
4. Perforate squeeze holes at 850' and 215'. Set cement retainer at 750'.
5. Mix and pump 42 sacks (49.6 cuft) cement below retainer
6. TOH and lay down tubing. Establish circulation down casing, through perforations at 215', up annulus and out bradenhead.
7. Mix and pump 67 sacks (79.1 cuft) cement down casing through perforations, up annulus and out bradenhead. Leave casing and annulus full of cement.
8. Cut off casing and install regulation dry hole marker. Reclaim location per BLM regulations.
