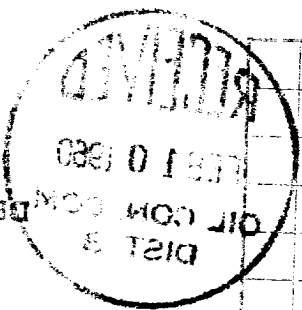

THIS WELL WAS DRILLED TO 80' WITH ROTARY TOOLS WHERE 7 5/8" SURFACE casing was run and cemented with 50 sacks of regular cement. The cement was allowed to set. After cement had hardened, the well was drilled with rotary tools to 549'. No water or oil was encountered. The well was plugged from 423' to 549' with 30 sacks of neat cement. The interval from 426' to 25' was filled with mud. The well was plugged with 5 sacks of neat cement from the surface to 25' and a 48 x 4" steel marker cemented in the surface pipe. The location was cleaned and leveled.
