This well was spudded on March 31, 1957, and on March 31, 1957, 8-5/8" casing was set at 321' with 250 sacks cement. After waiting on cement for 24 hours casing and water shut off were tested with 500 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
