DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Moved in cable tools, pulled 1" tubing, cleaned out to bottom, Sand-oil treated from 2669' to 2745' with 9,930 gallons diesel oil and 15,000' sand, flushed with 2,600 gallons diesel oil. Breakdown pressure 1500', maximum treating pressure 1500', minimum 1200', injection rate 42.5 barrels per minute.

After 12 hours flowing at rate of 1,100 MCF/day.
