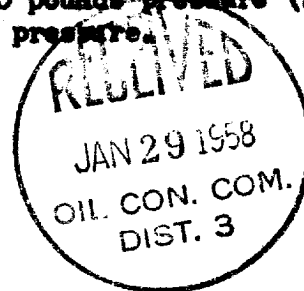

DETAILS OF WORK

In-Ni-Da-Pah Well No. 2. On January 9, 1958, 5-1/2" casing was set at 4943' with 75 sacks 5% gel cement, and followed by 75 sacks neat cement. After waiting on cement, 5-1/2" casing was tested with 2500 pounds pressure (special test) for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure.
