Drilled 13-3/4" hole to 215' EB. Ran 5 joints 9-5/8" OD James Casing equipped with Texas pattern shoe. Landed at 213' EB and cemented with 200 sac regular cement. Good returns to surface. Worked 24 hours, drilled out cement and tested Casing to 450 psi. Hold OK, now drilling ahead.
