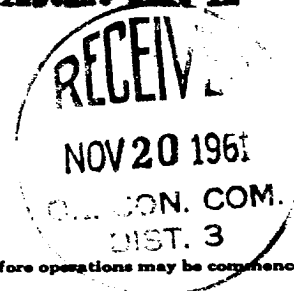

DETAILS OF WORK

11-15-61. Moved in and rigged up cable tools. Pulled rods and tubing. Rigged up Halliburton and loaded hole and broke down with 94 EO at 1300 psi to 1500 psi at 26 BPM. Sand fraced with 20,000 lb. 20-40 sand in 20,250 gallons oil. Mixed 750# SPC-3 in first 15,000 lb. sand. Treated at 1300 psi to 1500 psi at 26.5 to 27.5 BPM. Flushed with 130 barrels oil at 27.0 BPM. Instant shut in pressure 900 psi. Job completed at 9:06 AM 11-15-61.
