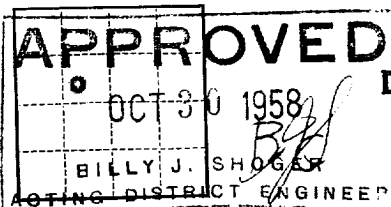

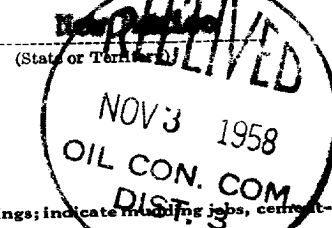

DETAILS OF WORK

The production for this well has declined to a point where it is under 50 MCF per month and there are no prospects for returning it to a commercial well. We propose to plug and abandon this well as follows:

The 8-5/8" casing set at 24' and 5-1/2" casing set at 1971' will be left in the hole. A 20 sack cement plug will be spotted from 1989' to 1900', covering open hole from 1971' to 1989' and a 10 sack cement plug will be spotted from 60' to surface. The casinghead will be removed and a dry hole marker will be cemented in top of the hole.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
