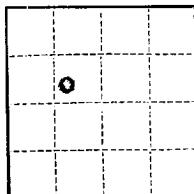

DETAILS OF WORK

On October 31, 1958, well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

The 3-5/8" casing set at 94' and 5-1/2" casing set at 1971' was left in the hole. A 20 sack cement plug was spotted from 1900' to 1969' and a 10 sack plug was spotted from 60' to surface. A 4" pipe marker was cemented in top of hole with 4' extending above ground level.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
