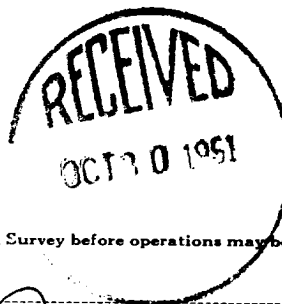
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 6796 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

August 24, 1961 - Perforated to test Gallup. Perforated 6 bullets per foot 3959-6000' (66 holes). Frased with 77,000 of 20/40 sand and 42,000 gallons oil. Tested 36 barrels oil per day after load oil.

October 6, 1961 - Installed pumping unit and 2" x 14" x 12' insert pump. Tested 14 barrels on October 11, 1961 and 13 barrels on October 12, 1961.
