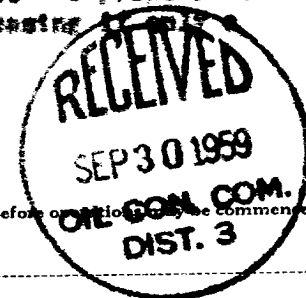

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to reenter this former El Paso Natural Gas Products Co. No. 1-A sandstone well abandoned at 5293 feet and deepen to approximately 6750 feet to test the Meseta formation. If a dry hole we will plug the hole in accordance with instructions of the U. S. Geological Survey at Farmington. If commercial oil or gas production is encountered we propose to set casing through the pay, perforate, and sandfree. We propose to set 7" casing if dual production is indicated and 5 1/2" casing if only a single pay is encountered.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
