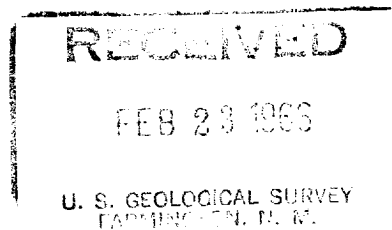

Drilled to T.D. 6510'. Run 200 lbs 1-1/2" OD 20.5' casing out at 6535', stage collar at 1521'. Cased last stage w/300 gr Class "C", 65 gal. 120 Gallons/24, tested w/200 gr Class "C" mud, 1-1/2" fluid would not hold. Run temp survey, top out @ 1285', bottom @ 6000', plug @ 6010'. Held stage collar @ 1521', went to 75 @ 6000, held fluid, then 30 class. Run Iowa-Wellbore ID tool. Indicated very porous 6000-6010'. Conditioned hole. Run Model K cement retainer on 1-1/2" OD tubing, set retainer @ 6100'. Reamed lower section of casing. Cemented casing with 200 mesh Class "A", size out 60 gr, left 200 gr behind pipe, job completed @ 1:15 pm 2/3/66. On log was a size 14 hrs. Rotated off retainer and pulled setting tool. VOC to 1 a.m. 2/3/66.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
