That the applicant herein, Shell Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Carson Unit 24 Well No. 1 located in Unit A) of Section 24, Township 25 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Menefee and Point Lookout formations at approximately 2835 feet to approximately 3815 feet through tubing with a packer set at approximately 2500 feet.

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commissi may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
