DETAILS OF WORK

This well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner:

1. Spotted 25 sack cement plug from cleaned out depth (2350') to 2150'. Pictured Cliffs perforations were from 2244' to 2256'.
2. Shot off 5 1/2" casing at 1003' and pulled.
3. Spotted 25 sack cement plug in top of 5 1/2" casing stub.
4. Placed 10 sack cement plug at surface, erected 4" x 4' marker and restored location to original contours. Plugging completed December 18, 1958.
