950' FNL; 1600' FWL T. Section 26-T25N-R11W San Juan County, New Mexico

The well will serve as a produced water disposal well for the Fruitland coal seam water from nearby production wells. Produced in water disposal in the commingled Dakota and Mesa Verde formations is requested.
