

Gentlemen:

This office received your Well Completion Report dated August 19, 1981 for well No. 303 Mudge located in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, sec. 16, T. 25 N., R. 11 W., San Juan County, New Mexico on Federal lease No. NM-036253, showing no production. On September 17, 1981 Mr. Carl Collins indicated that the No. 303 Mudge pressures up to approximately 1000 psig when the well is shut-in.

Therefore, a production test on the No. 303 Mudge must be performed within 60 days from the date of this letter to determine if the well is capable of producing in paying quantities. Authority for this action is contained in 30 CFR 221.34.
