Ladd, Jr., District Drilling Superintendent, Union Oil Company of California, that the approval for the abandonment of Navajo K-19 Well No. 4 could not be finalized due to Northwest Pipeline's dogleg on the location. Mr. Ladd spoke to Art Alsop, who was sitting in for Jim West of Northwest, and Mr. Alsop informed Mr. Ladd that the dogleg was live and that they had tied the Navajo X-19 Well No. 4 into the existing dogleg in order to utilize their existing right-of-way.
