Dear Doug:

*A field inspection conducted on September 16, 1994 revealed that the production pits associated with the referenced well contain oil and are in violation of Order R-8952 (for protection of migratory birds). The separator pit contains about 2 BBLS of water with a skim of oil and the tank drain pit contains about 5 BBLS of oil. Also exceptions to exception to the Order (form C-134) have not been filed. You are hereby directed to bring the subject pits into compliance prior to October 19, 1994.*
