Hunter Wash Well No. 2

WELL DATA:

Location: 860' FNL, 330' FWL, Section 22, T25N, R12W
San Juan County, New Mexico

TD: 4925'
PBTD: 4870'

Surface Casing: 8-5/8", 24 ppf, J-55 set @ 226'. Cement w/ 200 sks cement.

Production Casing: 4-1/2", 10.5 & 9.5 ppf, K-55, set @ 4814'. Cement with 425 sks cement.

Perforations: 4768' - 4776, 4791' - 4799' and 4806' - 4810' w/ 1 JSPF

PROCEDURE:

10/01/97 Pulled and laid down rods. Set cement retainer at 4576'.

10/30/97 Pumped 36 sacks (42.5 cuft) cement. Formation pressured up before cement placed under retainer. Pulled out of retainer and spotted from 4576' to 4101'. Perforate squeeze holes at 1480'. TIH w/ retainer and set at 1433'.

10/31/97 Pumped 340 sacks (401.2 cuft) cement below retainer and 71 sacks (83.8 cuft) cement above retainer. TOC at 500'. Perforated at 276'. Pumped 111 sacks (131.0 cuft) cement down casing and out bradenhead. Cut off wellhead and installed regulation dry hole marker with 34 sacks (40.1 cuft) cement. Dug up anchors and cleaned location.
