Tripped in the hole with 1-1/2" internal plastic coated tubing. Filled casing with packer fluid. Pumped out pump--out plug in injection packer. Released packer. Spaced out tubing. Reset packer at 4752'. Performed Mechanical Integrity Test. Tested to 300 psi for 30 minutes. Held. Test was witnessed by Charlie Gholson of NMOCD. Well ready for water injection.
