A gas transmission line is proposed to be laid along side the lease road from Texakoma's Crow Flat #1 to the Section line. The approximate length will be 1,434.446' to the east line of Section 21, and will be 3.0" SDR-7 Thermo-plastic pipe. The SDR-7 pipe has a maximum working pressure of 260 psi at 73.4° F. We intend to be operating the line at ± 50 psi. Attached is a plat showing the course of the pipeline.

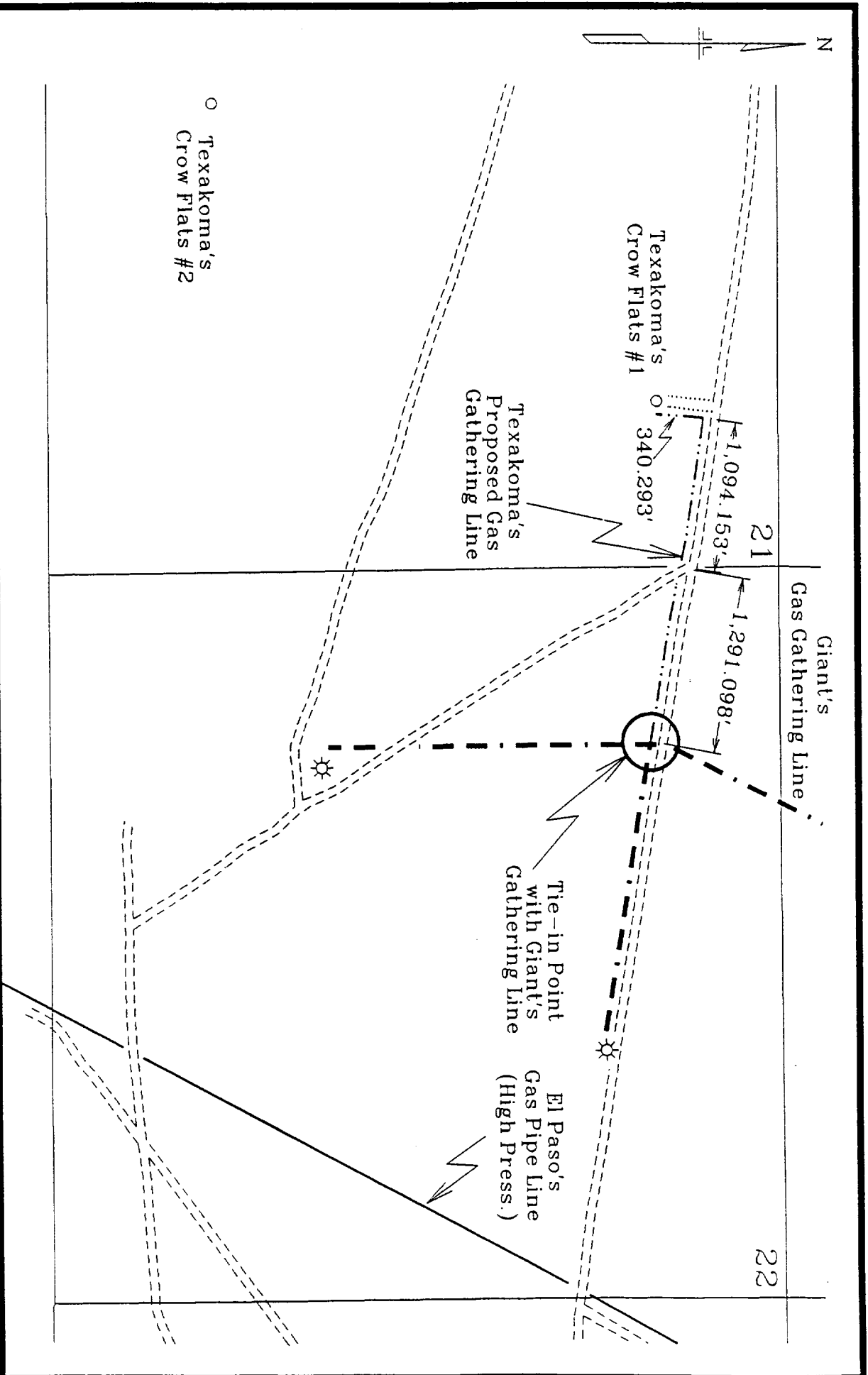
